The following two tweets in June,2008 are the first uses of "RT" as neat format of "Re-tweeting" in twitter sphere.













Social Media Pipeline (Isaac Mao, 2010)


Interregional connectivity of macaque visual cortex (Felleman and Van Essen, 1991)
