- ✓ Speed (must follow)

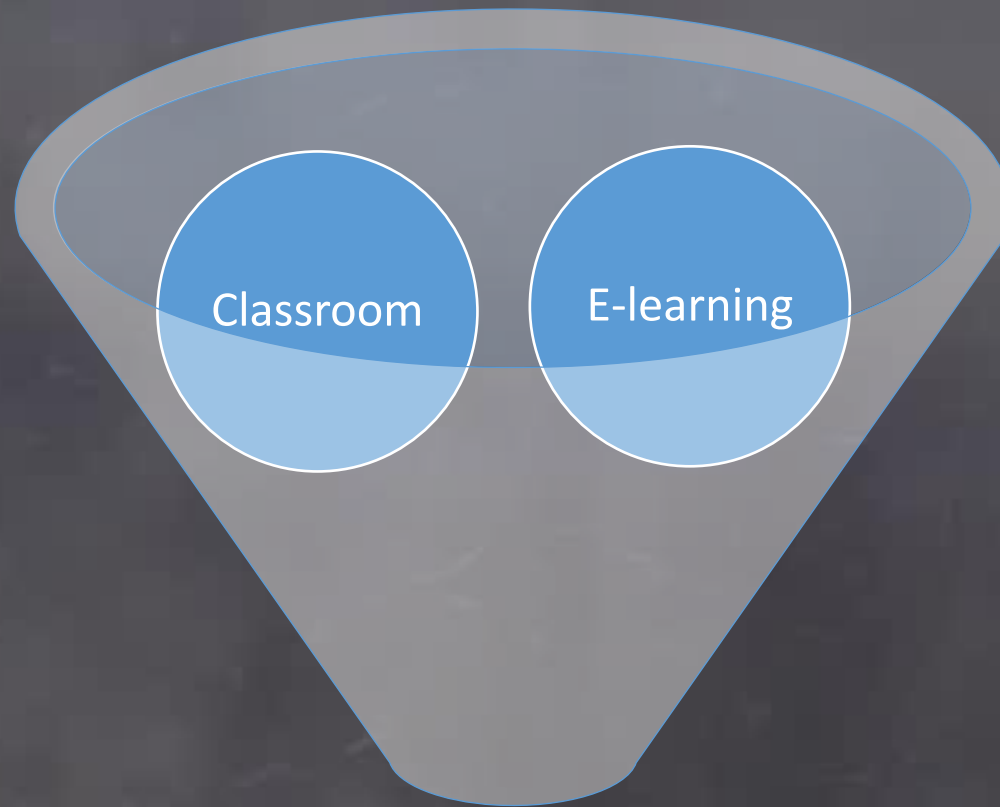
